

El Salvador “LIFE Team” Missions Project

May 1st to May 14th, 2010

El Salvador is the smallest country in Central America. It is wedged in between Guatemala and Honduras and bordered on its southwest side by the Pacific Ocean. El Salvador is home to 6,500,000 people who are said to be very friendly, industrious, and hospitable. It is the most densely populated state on the mainland of the Americas.



We met **Pastor Nelson Juarez and his wife Consuelo** while we were working with the Jesus Film in Belize. They have been church planters in both El Salvador and Belize since 1994. They lived and worked in El Salvador for ten years before they decided to expand their ministry into the country of Belize. Eventually they moved their family to Belize where they now live and work to evangelize, nurture new believers, and train spiritual leaders who will gradually provide leadership in the new churches that are being planted. Even though they now focus a lot of their energies into planting new churches in Belize they continue to offer support and encouragement to the local churches they have helped to establish in El Salvador.

For years Nelson and Consuelo have had to minister in El Salvador with very limited resources at their disposal. Many of the people that they seek to help constantly struggle to find enough food to eat and adequate housing for themselves and their families. For years they have prayed that others would come and help with the work. Could we be the answer to their prayers? Could we help to provide for the physical and spiritual needs of some of El Salvador’s poor? With God’s help I believe that we can make a difference in El Salvador. We could partner with Nelson and Consuelo who have established relief programs through their churches to distribute food to the poorest people living in the communities where they minister. We could help families to obtain basic housing by assisting them to construct simple homes made with cement blocks and metal sheeted roofs. As we invest our time, energy and resources into these types of relief ministries we extend the love of God to the poor of El Salvador. We also encourage and assist our Christian brothers and sisters in El Salvador who are seeking to help Salvadorians to truly discover Jesus Christ and to experience the abundant life that He offers to everyone!

Our hope is that we will be able to bring a team from Canada to El Salvador in May 2010 in order to help with the work that Nelson and Consuelo are doing. You can be part of a GAIN LIFE team that will work closely with local churches from El Salvador. Through your participation people will see and experience God’s love in real and very meaningful ways. Seekers will also receive guidance and support from local believers who are motivated to help them to realize how they can enter into a life changing relationship with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
