This project however, as you are probably aware, consisted of more than just building Rosa a house. Every evening teams of local believers joined us as we traveled to several different communities to help Salvadorians discover Jesus and experience the hope and joy that they so earnestly long for. In all our teams did a total of **13 Jesus Film showings** in 6 of the communities where new church plants have recently been established. We estimated that approximately **1050 people viewed the film** providing the new churches with many new contacts including **at least 100 adults and children who expressed a desire to receive God's gift of eternal life**. I know that God has heard the prayers of each and everyone who responded to His invitation in faith. His Spirit now dwells within them as He does in the life of every person who humbly acknowledges their deep spiritual need and turns to God who desires to have a personal and meaningful relationship with them.

It was a joy and a privilege for Grace and me to witness once again how God is working in the lives of so many people in the country of El Salvador! Lives are being transformed and new churches are being planted because of your prayers and faithful contributions! Each time we return to that country we are encouraged as we visit with and work alongside of our friends and brothers in Christ who seek to glorify God as they minister to the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of those who live in their communities.
